

CT CALCIUM SCORING NOW AT HVI WALL Identify calcified plaque in your arteries to determine the risk for heart disease or heart attack

This non-invasive procedure usually takes about 15 minutes. Calcium amounts are counted (scored) to determine the risk for heart disease or heart attack.

Calcium scoring is for a person who

- has high blood pressure, cholesterol, or hyperlipidemia.
- smokes or has a smoking history.
- is obese and, or has an inactive lifestyle.
- has congenital heart disease or a family history of heart disease.
- had a heart attack.
- has unexplained chest pain.
